## Typical work activities / responsibilities:

- Operates a truck for the application of sand/salt on icy roads, transportation of stone/gravel, supplies and other materials, and for the removal of snow, brush, refuse, and other items associated with public works activities.
- Operates a truck or tractor with the snow loader, snowplow, or other attachment.
- Operates light automotive equipment such as loaders, rollers, and backhoes used in road, street, and rural highway construction, repair, and maintenance.
